

## Be part of the Dialogue

Dublin Port will reach its maximum throughput capacity some time between 2030 and 2040 and <u>additional</u> port capacity will be needed elsewhere on the east coast of Ireland to cater for the growth which Dublin Port will not be able to accommodate once this point has been reached.

Building large new infrastructure takes at least twenty years from concept to completion.

Dublin Port Company (DPC) is now beginning to plan projects to deliver this additional capacity if it is to be available by 2040.

The final development projects at Dublin Port and projects to deliver new port capacity elsewhere are challenging. It is important that there is an opportunity for informed debate and discussion on the environmental, planning and financial challenges which these projects will create.
