MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Routine maintenance dredging will take place in the port and its approaches commencing Monday, 20th June 2016. This work is to be carried out by the trailing suction dredger "FREEWAY". (LOA 91.2m Beam 19m)

Bottom leveling will be carried out by the workboat "UKD SEALION" & "DPC Rosbeg".

Hydrographic surveys will be ongoing and they will be carried out by the boat F48.

All craft will monitor channel 12 continuously and show the required lights and shapes. All vessels should pass at slow speed and make due allowance for this operation.

During the dredging campaign it may be necessary to remove channel marker buoys at different stages. If a buoy is removed every effort will be made to have it back on-station as soon as is possible.

VTS will keep all vessels updated and advised of any relevant information.

This maintenance dredge campaign should last for a period of approximately five weeks.
