This is an application only and does not constitute permission from DPC to install traffic management. On receipt of the completed form, further information may be required by DPC. No traffic management installations are permitted within DPC estate until written permission from DPC is received by the applicant in the form of a permit to work.

- 3) confirms that, where applicable, 'as built' information is to be stored appropriately and forwarded to DPC.**

- 5) confirms that if required at any point DPC may instruct the TTM is removed and details of the time spans for same must be provided in the Method Statement.**
