

# NOTICE TO MARINERS

## Weather Warning – Storm Éowyn

Masters, Warranted Pilots, Holders of Pilotage Exemption Certificates, Owners, Operators and Agents of all Vessels navigating within Dublin Port are hereby notified that;

Met Eireann have issued a status **RED** weather warning for the named storm “Éowyn” where gale to storm force southerly winds becoming westerly with extreme, damaging and destructive gusts in excess of 130km/h (70knots) are forecast.

The Dublin Port navigational channel and fairway will be closed to vessel movements from 2hours before the **RED** warning until 2hours after. During subsequent warnings vessel movements will be subject to Harbour Master approval and will be communicated locally and via VTS.

Cargo handling operations will not be permitted from 2hours before the **RED** warning until 2hours after.

Vessels in Port should take all seamanlike precautions to secure for the strong winds including deploying additional moorings taking the forecast conditions into consideration. Consideration should be given to the provision of safe access and ramp interface, in the event of shore-side power loss. Ships crew should follow government guidelines and take shelter in place, onboard their vessel during the **RED** warning.
