

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Survey Operations – Soldiers Point Dundalk

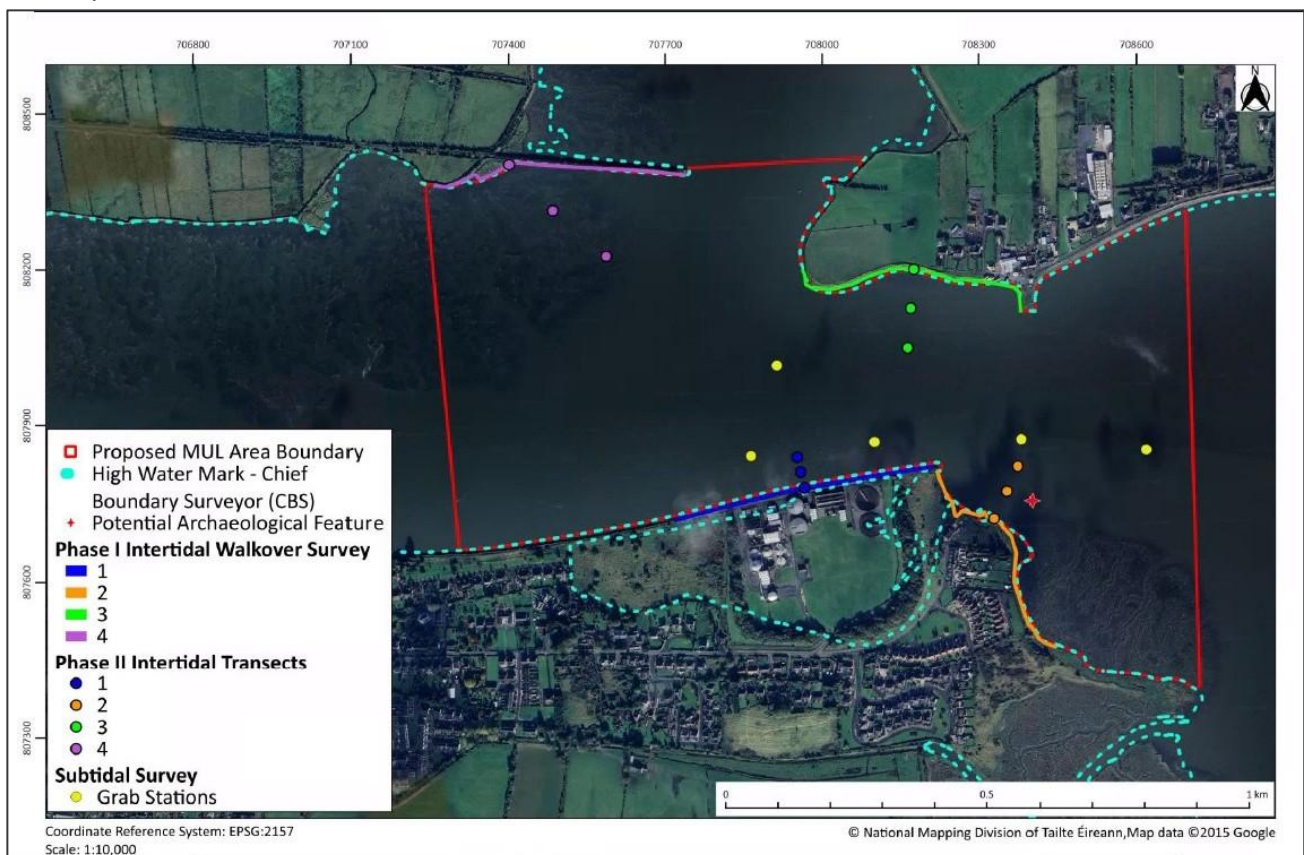
Masters, Warranted Pilots, Owners, Operators and Agents of all vessels navigating within Dundalk Port are hereby notified that Aquafact, acting on behalf of Uisce Éireann, will be conducting environmental surveys at Soldiers Point, on the southern side of the Castletown Estuary, County Louth.

The surveys will include:

- an intertidal walkover survey conducted from the shore; and
- a subtidal survey involving the deployment of grab sampling and drop-down video equipment from a survey vessel.

The surveys are scheduled to take place from 04 August to 07 August 2026, inclusive.

The survey area is indicated on the chart extract below;

All craft will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 16.

All vessels navigating in the vicinity are requested to; navigate with caution when transiting survey area, maintain a safe distance from the survey vessel and associated equipment.
