

NOTICE TO MARINERS

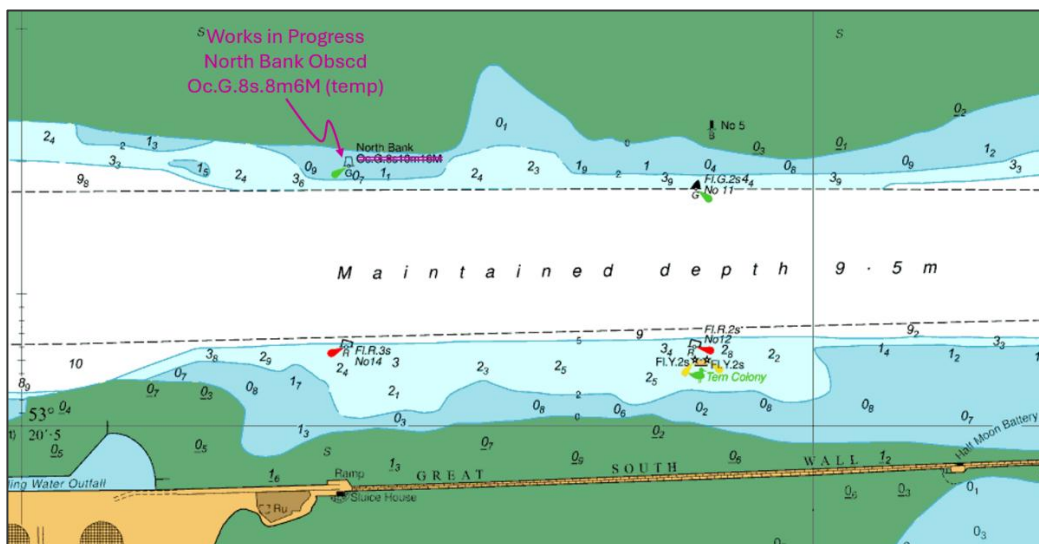
North Bank Lighthouse – Works in Progress

Masters, Warranted Pilots, Holders of Pilotage Exemption Certificates, Owners, Operators and Agents of all vessels navigating within Dublin Port are hereby notified that Dublin Port Company will undertake upgrade works to the North Bank Lighthouse commencing on or about 10 August 2026 for a period of approximately three months.

The works will include structural improvements to the lighthouse together with upgrades to the power supply and light.

During the course of the works;

- The lighthouse structure may be partially or fully obscured by scaffolding and associated construction materials.
- The existing aid to navigation light will be replaced by a temporary self contained navigation light. The temporary light will maintain the existing flash characteristic, however the elevation will be lower and the nominal range will be reduced to approximately 6 nautical miles for the duration of the works. (Oc.G.8s.8m6M).

All craft engaged in the works will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 12 and will display the appropriate lights, shapes and signals as required by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREGs).

Mariners navigating in the vicinity are requested to exercise caution, maintain an appropriate lookout, and take account of the reduced light range when passage planning and navigating within Dublin Bay and approaches to Dublin Port.

Dublin Port VTS will promulgate relevant navigational information and traffic updates on VHF Channel 12.
