

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Maintenance Dredging Campaign

Masters, Warranted Pilots, Holders of Pilotage Exemption Certificates, Owners, Operators and Agents of all Vessels navigating within Dublin Port are hereby notified of the following dredging works;

From 03 September for a period of approximately 3 weeks. Dublin Port together with Jan De Nul will engage in a Maintenance Dredging Campaign.

Dredging works will take place in the outer and inner fairway and in all berths throughout the Port. The following craft will be involved in dredging operations;

Dredger	<i>Diogo Cao</i>
Bed Leveller	<i>Cosette</i>
Survey Boat	<i>Barnicle</i>

All craft will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 and show the required lights and shapes. All vessels should pass at slow speed and make due allowance for their operations and restricted manoeuvrability.

To facilitate the dredging operations fairway lateral buoys may be temporarily moved or taken off station, this notice will be updated to reflect any planned buoy movements.

VTs will keep all vessels updated and advise of any relevant information on VHF Channel 12.
